

Audit Summary- May 4, 2010 Primary Election

On June 7th and 8th, 2010, eight bi-partisan teams completed the May 4, 2010 Primary Election Audit. State Issue 1 was audited on a total 12,854 ballots from 58 different precincts with a 100% accuracy rate.

A total of 234,591 ballots were cast in the May 4, 2010 Primary Election. In accordance with Ohio Secretary of State Directive 2008-113, minimum number of ballots to be audited equals 11,730 (5% of total ballots cast).

Fifty-four precincts were randomly selected, totaling 11,844 ballots to be audited. In addition to those fifty-four precincts, the four precincts which experienced DS200 power down/freeze issues on Election-Day were also audited. This accounts for the additional 1,010 ballots.

State Issue 1 was hand counted by bi-partisan teams and in all fifty-eight precincts the hand count results matched the UNITY Official Canvass results exactly.
