THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS IS HIRING OVER 5,000 WORKERS FOR THE MARCH 15, 2016 PRIMARY ELECTION

The Board of Elections is seeking temporary help and poll workers and is now taking applications for more than 5,000 paid positions. “Our democracy depends on citizens being engaged in the election process,” said Pat McDonald the Director of the Board of Elections. “Poll workers are the backbone of all elections as they assist voters on Election Day and temporary personnel help with vital administrative work before, during and following each election,” said McDonald.

Poll Workers earn up to \$200.00 for their service, which includes successfully completing a poll worker training class and attending a meeting the night before the election.

Over 150 temporary staff are being hired to perform a wide range of duties. These jobs can last up to several months.
