## School/Library/Special Issues

### BROOKLYN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

#### **Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)**

Shall a levy be imposed by the Brooklyn City School District for the purpose of avoiding an operating deficit in the sum of \$2,250,000 and a levy of taxes be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average 6.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 69 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of ten years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020?

### EUCLID LIBRARY DISTRICT

#### **Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Euclid Public Library for the purpose of current expenses of the Euclid Public Library at a rate not exceeding 5.6 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 56 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2019, first due calendar year 2020.

### PARMA CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

#### **Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Parma City School District for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of the School District in the sum of \$9,197,860 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average 4.2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 42 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of ten years, commencing in 2020, first due in calendar year 2021?

### STRONGSVILLE CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

#### **Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)**

An additional tax for the benefit of the Strongsville City School District for the purpose of current expenses at a rate not exceeding 5.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 59 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.

# Municipal Issues

## **VILLAGE OF MAYFIELD VILLAGE**

### **Proposed Zoning Amendment**

Shall the Zoning Map of the Village of Mayfield be amended to change the zoning classification of PP#'s 831-10-021, 831-10-007, 831-10-005, 831-10-004, 831-10-006, and 831-10-003, located on Highland Road, from the current U-1 Single Family Residential District and Production-Distribution District to the Planned Residential Development District?

## **VILLAGE OF BRATENAHL**

### **Proposed Income Tax Proposed Municipal Income Tax**

Shall Ordinance No. 4014 providing for an increase in the rate of the municipal income tax from the current rate of one and one-half percent to a rate of two percent upon taxable income effective June 1, 2019 and thereafter, for the purpose of providing funds for operating expenses of the police department, fire and EMS service costs and Village vehicle replacement funds be passed.

## **CITY OF BROADVIEW HEIGHTS**

### **Proposed Zoning Amendment**

Shall Permanent Parcel Nos. 584-08-004, 584-08-005, 584-08-006 and 584-08-007 located on the North side of Route 82 between Seneca Boulevard and Oakwood Trail be rezoned from present A-1 (Single Family Dwelling) to Special Planning District Zone B.

## **VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS**

### **Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of Chagrin Falls for the purpose of current expenses at a rate not exceeding 5.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty-five cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years.

## **VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD**

### **Proposed Charter Amendment**

Shall Article X of the Charter of the Village of Oakwood be amended and supplemented by a new Section 10.13 authorizing Village Council to permit the construction and operation of video and audio recording, production and editing facilities, helicopter landing and take-off pads accessory to such uses, and passive parks and nature preserves in the area contained within the following boundaries which area is presently zoned R1F Residential: Solon Road on the North, Richmond Road on the East, Hawthorne Parkway on the South and the Oakwood Village border with the City of Bedford Heights on the West, subject to such standards and requirements as are to be established by ordinance of Council?

## **CITY OF PARMA**

### **Proposed Resolution**

Shall Section 618.09 (c) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, which prohibits, within the City, the owning, harboring, or keeping of a pit bull dog, defined by Section 618.01 (z) to include the American Pit Bull Terrier, as recognized by the United Kennel Club, and the American Staffordshire Terrier, the Staffordshire Bull Terrier and the Bull Terrier, as recognized by the American Kennel Club, and any mixed breed of dog which contains as an element of its breeding any of the breeds described, be repealed?

**CITY OF SEVEN HILLS**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the City of Seven Hills for the purpose of acquiring motorized vehicles and equipment, including a street sweeper, a tractor with front-end loader and a backhoe, a mower, dump trucks, pick-up trucks, and snow plow assemblies, salt spreaders and other related equipment therefor, for use in carrying out functions of the Department of Public Service at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 5 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.

**CITY OF STRONGSVILLE**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the City of Strongsville for the purpose of current expenses at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 15 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.
