

Key Points pertaining to Directive 2020-06

- The CCBOE is currently collecting Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballot applications for the 2020 Presidential Primary Election.
 - Applications can be printed from the CCBOE website, www.443vote.us, utilizing the “Vote-by-Mail” button on the homepage of the website. This is the preferred method.
 - VBM ballot applications can also be obtained from the CCBOE Administration Building between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
 - Voters must complete all sections of the application, including selecting a Party style in Section 4.
- Per the Secretary of State’s Office, the CCBOE is not permitted to provide VBM ballots to voters at this time for any VBM ballot applications received after 12 noon on March 14, 2020. The CCBOE is awaiting further guidance from the Secretary of State. The VBM ballot applications are currently being compiled for future processing.
- The CCBOE offices are **not** open for Early In-Person voting pursuant to the Directive.
- Absentee ballots issued by the CCBOE prior to March 17, 2020 can be dropped-off to the CCBOE. Voters can return them by mail or deposit them into the ballot boxes located at the CCBOE Administration Building at 2925 Euclid Ave, Cleveland, Ohio, 44115.
