THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS IS OPEN FOR WEEKEND VOTING IN THE FEBRUARY 3, 2015 SPECIAL ELECTION

Beachwood and Brook Park voters will go to the polls next Tuesday to cast ballots in the February 3rd Special Election. The Board of Elections will also be open for voting this weekend. “There are many advantages to weekend voting,” said Pat McDonald the Director of the Board of Elections. “We offer free parking, no lines to vote, and you won’t have to take the time out of your schedule to vote on Tuesday,” said McDonald.

Early voting is available:

Saturday: January 31st: 8:00 a.m. to Noon
Sunday: February 1st: 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Monday: February 2nd: 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

People who cast ballots by mail are reminded that voted ballots must be postmarked on, or before, February 2nd.

The deadline for returning ballots in person is February 3rd at 7:30 p.m. Ballots **cannot** be dropped off at polling locations on Election Day. Ballots that are not mailed can only be returned in person to the Board of Elections.

Voters may utilize the drive through ballot box located in the Board of Elections parking lot at 2925 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland. The secure ballot box is available 24 hours a day.

It is important for voters to be prepared to cast their ballots on Election Day by confirming their ward, precinct, and voting location. Voters may call the Board at 216-443-VOTE to check their voting information or view on line at www.443vote.com. The polls will be open between 6:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
