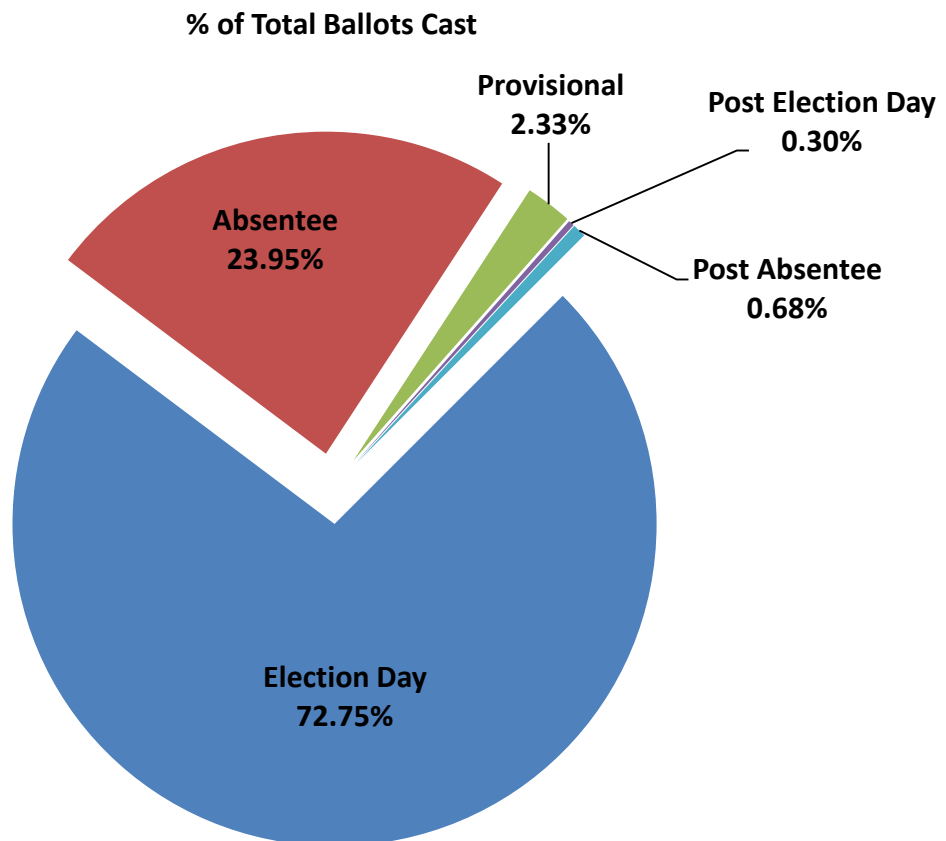
FINAL RESULTS

Official Election Results for the March 15, 2016 Primary Election are attached to the Election Summary Report.

SUMMARY OF OFFICIAL CANVASS

There were a total of 361,098 ballots tabulated for the March 15, 2016 Primary Election. Below is a breakdown of the ballots counted by category and a percentage of the total vote by category.

ABSENTEE / VOTE BY MAIL

The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections received a total of 98,816 valid Absentee/Vote by Mail applications. Of those requests, 90,163 ballots were returned (91.24%). The Ballot Department tabulated 88,945* Absentee/Vote by Mail Ballots of the applications processed. There were 1,218 ballots challenged in this election resulting in a challenge rate of 1.35%** . Details of the challenges are below.

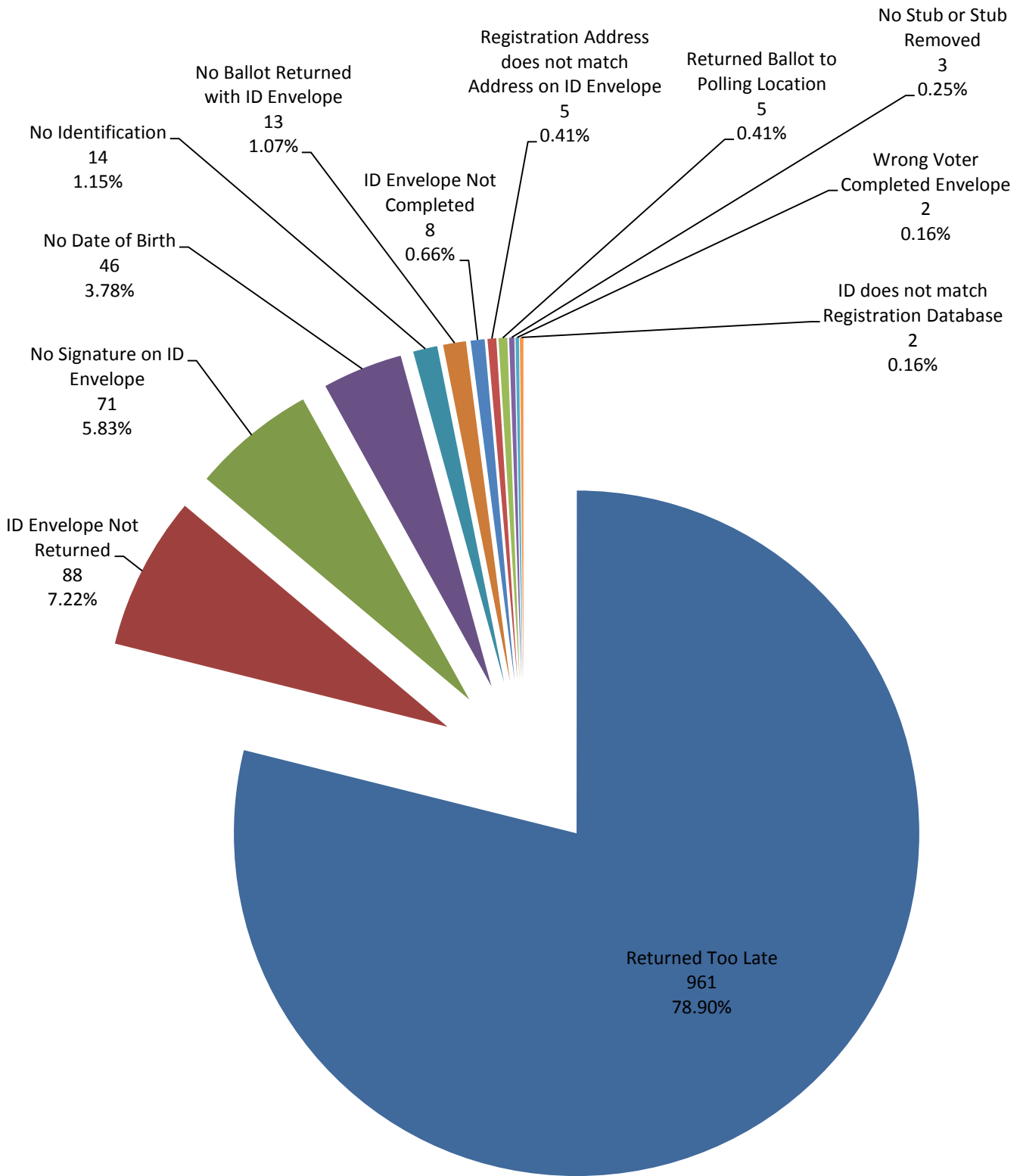
* Of the 88,945 valid ballots, 31 multi-page ballots were returned without the first page. The pages that were returned were tabulated, however only first pages are recorded numerically in the tabulating system, resulting in an Absentee Scan of 88,914 ballots recorded.

** The Absentee Ballot Challenge Rate is 0.29% when the Absentee Ballots postmarked after the deadline are excluded.

PROVISIONAL VOTING SUMMARY

A total of 10,401 Provisional Ballots were cast In-House and on Election Day. Of those ballots, 8,430* (81.05%) were valid and tabulated by the Ballot Department. There were 1,971 invalid Provisional Ballots resulting in a 18.95%** rejection rate for this election. Details of the rejections are below.

* Of the 8,430 valid ballots, 9 multi-page ballots were returned without the first page. The pages that were returned were tabulated, however only first pages are recorded numerically in the tabulating system, resulting in a Provisional Scan of 8,421 ballots recorded.

** The Provisional Ballot Rejection Rate is 7.53% when Provisional Voters who have already cast an Absentee Ballot and those who were not registered to vote are excluded.

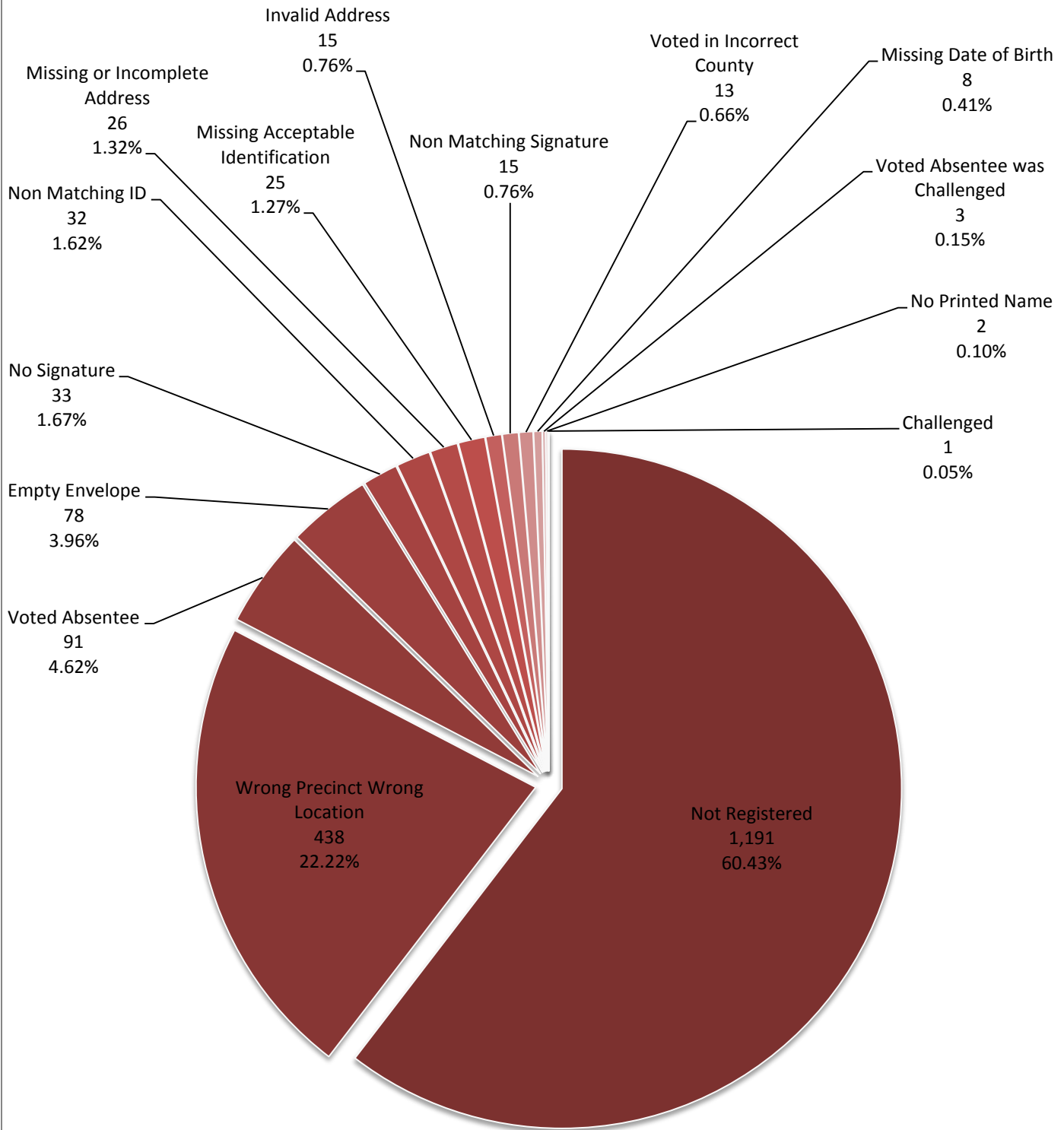

BALLOT REMAKES

During the election, 4,130 ballot pages were processed in accordance with the CCBOE Remake Policy (approved by the Board on May 17, 2013). Of those, 876 were processed during the Unofficial Canvass. The remaining 3,254 ballot pages were processed during the Official Canvass. The following is a breakdown by category:

OVER VOTES

There were a total of 1,746 over votes recorded, resulting in a 0.48% over vote rate for the election.

VOTER HISTORY /BALLOT RECONCILIATION

Nine hundred eighty (980) precincts were involved in this election, including five (5) Congressional split precincts which had to be separated by precinct portions for reporting purposes. Voter History is ongoing.

Ballot Reconciliation is currently being conducted.

RECOUNTS

There are no automatic recounts for this election.

The requested recount deadline is Monday, April 11th at 4:30PM.

AUDIT

The post-election audit will be conducted beginning Tuesday, April 12th at 10:00AM, provided there are no recounts. The audits will be conducted using the batch-based risk-limiting audit method. The following two contests are mandated by the Secretary of State, and the Board will randomly select the third contest in which the audit will be conducted:

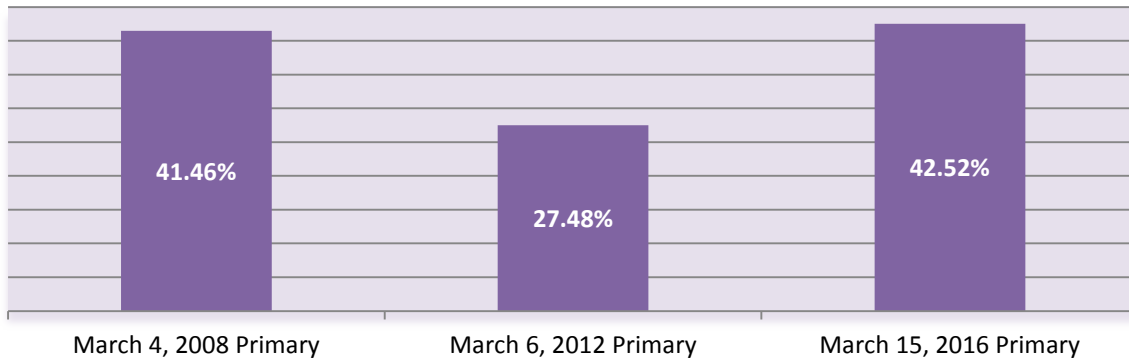
- Delegates-at-Large and Alternates-at-Large to the National Convention (Democratic)

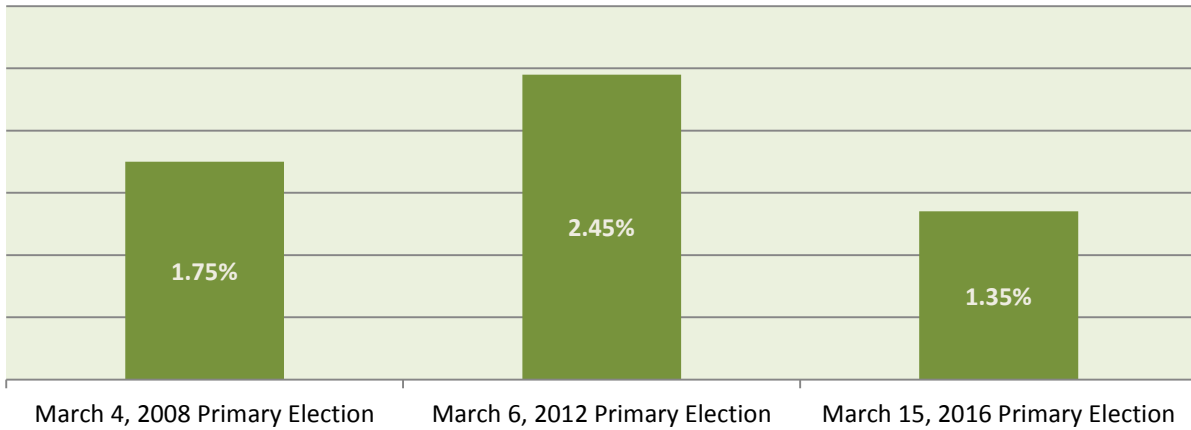
Voter Turnout by Category



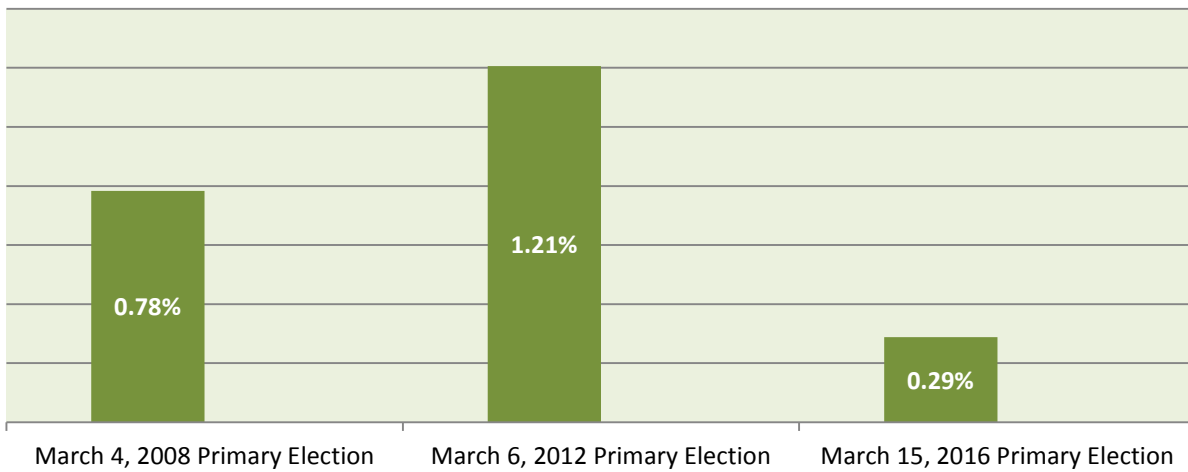

Challenge Rate



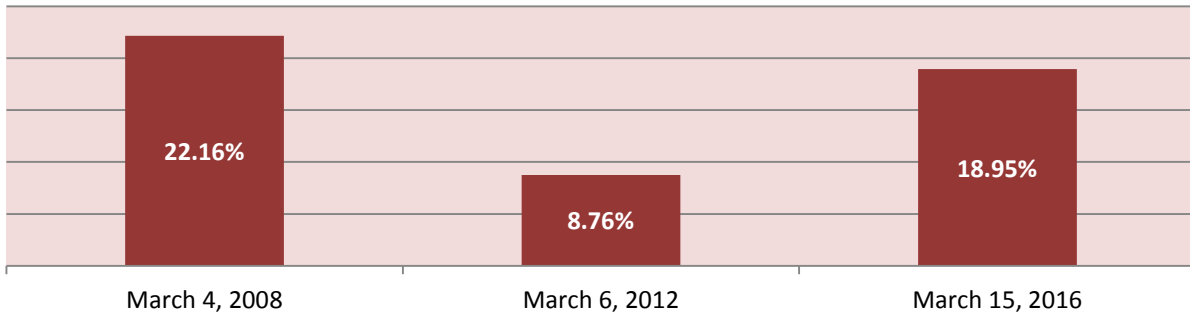
Challenge Rate (Excluding Late)



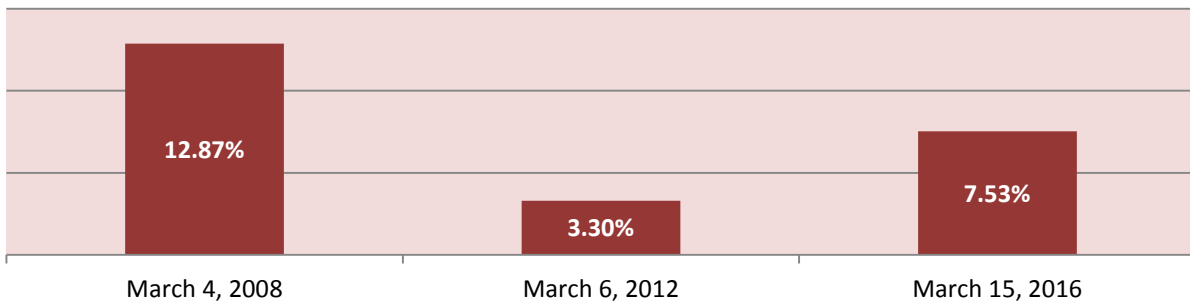
